1. Population

2. Monarchy

3. Unemployment

South Africa became a democratic country in April 1994, yet the people of the Zulu Nation are still struggling against poverty. In the province of KwaZulu, there is over 70% unemployment. To combat this, education in the farming trade and modern technology will create skilled employment.

4. Disease

HIV/AIDS is an epidemic that has killed people by the thousands. 1 out of every 5 people are HIV positive. 50% of the babies are born with AIDS and 3 million children have become orphans as a result of this dreadful disease. Farming the land will provide food for the orphans.



Farming Land:

His Majesty the King has provided 2,000 acres of fertile land for agricultural farming ranging from corn, pinto beans, black-eyed peas, and cabbage just to name a few.
